Australia's 8th largest city - and largest inland city - Canberra is home to so much more than the government. Of particular interest to marketers is the population of highly educated, happy and most highly paid consumers in Australia.

No matter what government is leading, Canberra is also a progressive city: It was the first Australian city to achieve 100% renewable energy; the first to legislate same-sex marriage; and the first to make Reconciliation Day a public holiday.

With some of the highest rates of recycling, bicycling and 100% renewable energy, Canberra has fast become Australia's city of sustainability.

Canberra has an incredibly diversified economy - blending education, government, defence, construction and healthcare - and consistently has one of the lowest unemployment rates, at just 3.1%.

As such it has:

- The highest Gross State Product (GSP) per capita
- The highest Gross Household Disposable Income per capita

Since 2014, the Canberra Innovation Network (CBRIN), supported by the ACT government and six of Canberra's leading universities and research centres, hosts year-round events to foster and fund innovative new companies and products.
